



Rebuilding Together Dutchess County Accepting Applications for No-Cost Home Repairs

Mission: Bringing volunteers and communities together to revitalize homes, assuring that qualified homeowners live independently in a warm, safe and dry environment.

Rebuilding Together is the nation's largest volunteer nonprofit organization working to preserve affordable homeownership by bringing volunteers and communities together to rehabilitate the homes of low-income homeowners at no cost to them. We are currently accepting applications for our 2014 Rebuilding Day Program. The application deadline is September 30, 2013 however interested applicants should apply as soon as possible to begin the process. Low-income Dutchess County homeowners, especially those who are elderly, living with a disability, veterans or parents with young children are encouraged to apply.

General Criteria for Application Eligibility

- Income eligibility is 80% or below the Dutchess County median household income
- Applicants must be Dutchess County residents and own and reside in the home seeking repairs
- All types of homes are eligible except for mobile homes on property owned by someone else
- Must be up to date in property and school taxes
- May not have missed any mortgage payments in the past year
- Must have homeowners insurance
- May not have filed for bankruptcy in the past year
- We cannot serve a homeowner more than once in a 5 year period, or more than twice total
- Required repairs fall within our mission of our warm, safe, dry, and independent
- The home's appraised value must be under \$247,285
