Hurricane Irene

A State of Emergency has been renewed for five (5) more days effective Wednesday, August 31, 2011 at 1:25pm

1. The first priority for road repairs by our Highway Department was for access (could our residents get in and out on their roads)

2. The second priority is based on damaged roads – top three (3) damaged are:

a. Salisbury Turnpike

b. Battenfeld Road

c. Rock City Road

3. You may have damage to the road you live on, but it may be a County road:

a. Turkey Hill Road

b. Round Lake Road

c. Academy Hill Road

4. Glenn Butler and his Highway crew are working to restore the damaged roads ASAP. PLEASE REFRAIN FROM SITE SEEING AND STOPPING WHERE CREWS ARE WORKING AS THIS HINDERS THEIR WORK WHEN THEY HAVE TO STOP WHILE PEOPLE ARE TAKING PICTURES.

5. Dry ice is no longer available in Dutchess County. Red Hook High School and the Red Cross Shelter are no longer open.

6. There are 16 outages remaining in Milan 90% of the 16 will be restored by 10PM tonight.
